No, that is forgiveness. Grace is when someone pays the price so I can be pure, like I never sinned.

This Thanksgiving, as we are sitting around the dinner table with family, thinking of what we can be thankful for - I will be thankful for God's grace - that He so freely gives to me.

It is free to me, but it cost God His Son.
