This program that John and Sally are using is based on the reality that all of us have made choices. Those choices have consequences and one of those consequences can be addiction. Therefor we need to train people how to make different/better choices.

2 Corinthians 5:17 says; Therefor if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.

How destructive it is to our faith, our testimony to the community and our view of ourselves as a child of God to stand up every week and say: "Hi. My name is John and I am an alcoholic." God wants to do a work in my life so I can stand up and say: "Hi. My name is John and I used to be an alcoholic." By saying "used to be" I am now giving God the credit for what I could not do on my own!

I have met the people in John and Sally's group who have been changed so dramatically as they grow into the freedom of "the old things are passed away". Yes, there are setbacks but they are becoming more comfortable accepting responsibility for what they have chosen and they aren't hiding behind a wall of shame.
