Since dad is not capable of being alone we decided (after more family consultations) that I would fly there and help out for two weeks. After medical tests showed she had a minor stroke it was time for another possible change.

Now they have someone coming in to help fix meals and do housework.

Looking back we see God at work! All of this happened because we were in Michigan to lead a "Raising Responsible Adults" seminar. We were amazed when we realized that scheduling this seminar had taken two years. The church and us would compare schedules and decide on a date then they would change staff and we would need to start all over again.

Two years to schedule a date and it finally happened at just the right time when we were able to help Dad and Gloria through this difficult time in their lives. God is so good!

Without you we could not impact the lives we are able to impact. Lives like Sheryl's folks. Not really part of the ministry we thought we would be having this fall, but this is what family does for each other.
