At the beginning of our time with Linda we could see in her eyes that she was "beaten". As she walked out the door the light in her eyes had changed to one of hope and peace.

The change we saw in Linda was not a surprise. Life Is Full Of Choices was created to bring hope to the hopeless.

No matter the setting - if we are working one-on-one around the table, leading a seminar about parenting or addiction or teaching leaders how to connect with their community - we get the fun of watching individuals and groups of people realize there is hope.

We have heard this before, but it is always special. The last thing Linda said as she walked out the door was, "Thank you for sharing this truth with me. It is so simple. I wish someone had shared it with me 20 years ago."
