No matter the amount of time it takes to understand "surrendering" or how successful we are in choosing to make that happen in our lives, it is important for us to surrender in order to keep ourselves available and connected with God!

It is a journey. Each and every one of us must choose to surrender to the Lord in the deepest parts of our hearts. The journey is best done together in community - not done alone.
