The Rest Of The Story

In our recent prayer letters we have shared about our travels around the United States.

As we were planning this trip – since we have been pulling the 5th wheel, I made the choice to stick to freeways and main roads to make traveling a little easier in case of emergencies. That was my choice!

I am therefore unable to blame anyone else for what happened on those roads; the two blowouts and the ruined transmission. I could blame the roads, the tire company for the tires, or the car company for the transmission but I have made the choice not to blame others and become a victim in these circumstances. Buying the truck, tires and the 5th wheel were my choices and therefore my responsibility.

When others blame me, and I accept that blame, I can begin to feel guilt. In this example there is no guilt because I have accepted responsibility for the choices that were mine and am not dealing with the choices that others made (the tire company and the car company).

I use this an an example of what happens as we raise our children.

Sheryl and I tried our best with our kids - but we made mistakes. For our mistakes we have apologized and are moving foreword because while we are responsible for our choices, we are not responsible for the choices our children are making.

So many of the people we are talking to, believe the lie that they are responsible, and are dealing with false guilt because their kids got pregnant, are using drugs or are running away from God.

Guilt, when from God, should lead us to repentance (and an apology for the choices we made that affected their circumstances). But an ongoing battle with guilt is not from God. It is from the enemy and it's purpose is to destroy my faith in God!

If you are dealing with this guilt, apologize for the choices you have made and move on. You are not responsible for your kids choices anymore than God is responsible for the choice Adam and Eve made. Trust God to deal with your kids.

If you know someone who is dealing with this guilt, share this letter with them and pray with them in order to help them understand their choices and the responsibility they have.

I am responsible for the roads I choose, I am not responsible for the road my kids choose or where it will take them!
