

I am talking with a family in Arizona. They are dealing with the circumstances around their 35 year old son who has never become a responsible adult.

The son has gone to college, he is married with two kids and still wants to live at home. In order to get him to move out they bought him a house and often make the payments. He has a job (not the one he wants), but never has the money to repair the house or cars so he is always asking for more.

They ask me what to do and I keep telling them "He will not start acting like an adult until you start treating him like one. You need to quit doing for him what he can do for himself."

They are caught in the trap of thinking their son is the lemon that is souring their life. The truth is, it is their choices that have produced the circumstances they don't like.

At this point in their lives, the good choices are going to be hard.

Unfortunately they are experiencing the reality that their circumstances are lemons, but they can learn how to make lemonade. In order to make lemonade you need to start with lemons, add water, sugar and stir.

Their choices have given them lemons. Their tough love and encouragement are the water and sugar. Life provides the stirring.

It is not fun telling people that their choices got them to where they are today. God never told Sheryl and me to go and have fun, He told us to go and make disciples. He told us to teach the gospel - and the gospel is all about choices.
